****Each high school in Henrico County will submit up to 6 entries. It is up to each high school to select the best posters for submission. Make the poster design clear, with high contrast, and without using copyright images.**

Contest Procedure

Art students who wish to compete will design a Crime Stoppers Poster must include the following elements of the Crime Stoppers Program:

- Crime Stoppers phone number: 780-1000
- “All calls are anonymous – no caller ID, no recording devices, no name.”
- Reward of up to \$1,000 if caller information assists with arrest.
- The Crime Stoppers Logo (see next page)

The preferred (and maximum) size is 11 x 14 inches.
The poster layout is to be **horizontal (Not vertical)**.

The winning poster from each jurisdiction will be submitted to the Board of Directors of Metro Richmond Crime Stoppers. The Board of Directors will determine the Grand Prize Winner

The Winner will attend the **April 25th** meeting of the Metro Richmond Crime Stoppers Board of Directors to receive the \$1,000. Winning posters become the property of Metro Richmond Crime Stoppers for a variety of uses, including reproduction, to promote the Crime Stoppers Program in the community.
